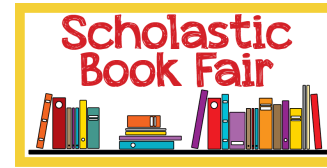

## St. Paul Early Learning Center Advisory Council

The St. Paul Early Learning Center Advisory Council met in the Learning Center Cafeteria on October 21st. The Council approved the pandemic leave policy: St. Paul Early Learning Center does not have the means to provide emergency paid leave during the current pandemic.

Jennifer reported there are 91 children currently. The Learning Center is working with Assistant Superintendent, Stephanie Brown, to implement FACTS. This is a program to help track and manage student data, monitor information, streamline information for parents and staff. The Center will transition to the tuition management part of FACTS for the 2021-2022 school year. Our next meetings will be November 18th.
