Advisory Council Update:

The Advisory Council met on ZOOM on March 24th. Jennifer reported that the Learning Center has received \$2850 for the Tom Mullen Memorial Fund. The Center will purchase iPads and three Osmo STEM toys. The Council discussed the new payment company FACTS. The Center will absorb the \$50 fee per family to implement this program. A letter will be sent to parents. The Council discussed preschool graduation possibilities. The Diocese has applied for the PPP for the Center.
